The date for the 2019 VFMC Convention is May 16 – 18, 2019.

The **President** passed out NFMC certificates to clubs and individuals for outstanding service.

President Dr. Elaine Brady stated her two goals for VFMC: 1. To improve communication – folders with chairs, their emails and other information 2. Start the new website which is easy to understand and to use for communication

The presentation and approval of the Budget has been changed to the spring VFMC meeting. The president attended the NFMC meeting in Milwaukee in June and reported on the 19 VFMC clubs. Please fill out and return reports to the president so your clubs can be included on our state report to National.

Finance Chairman Wendell Anderson brought recommendations from the Finance Committee: 1. Propose that the Festival Fees submitted to VFMC reflect the number of festival registrations (not just number of participants) Rationale: Clarity of statement for consistency of fees from all festivals **Approved**

2. Propose that the \$.50 reduction by NFMC for the on-line festival registration be retained by VFMC and applied to defray the cost of the Jr. Composers Contest (which is part of Festival) Rationale: This major Jr. contest needs funds for its financial support. **Approved**

3. Propose that contributions to the Mildred Thompson and Julia Fugua Ober Memorials be designated to support the biennial VFMC Student/Collegiate Auditions Rationale: S/C biennial auditions which include multiple instruments and voice need funds for its financial support.

Approved

4. Propose allocating a maximum of \$800 for biennial S/C Auditions to cover 4 groups (@\$200) of 13 categories (1.strings/guitar; 2. harp/piano/percussion/organ; 3. wind/brass instruments; and 4. voice.) Rationale: to cover an unpredictable number of biennial applicants and to set a maximum allocation for 4 groups of categories Approved

5. Recommend the VFMC set the Dance Scholarship awards for Juniors as follows: First place \$400, Second place \$250. In addition, that the entry fee be set at \$20.00 Approved

6. The VFMC establish a Junior Blind Performance Award. Applicant must provide an affidavit from an ophthalmologist stating the entrant legally blind with 20/200 or less vision after correction. The awards amounts: First place \$175, Second place \$150 Approved

7. That the VFMC set the entry fee for the Stillman Kelley/Thelma Byrum Award Competition at \$20.00 Approved

8. Remove the third place award in the Stillman Kelley/Thelma Byrum Award to bring it in line with other scholarships/competitions. Approved

9. The VFMC set the entry fee for the Student/Collegiate Auditions at \$20.00 Approved

New Business:

Virginia will be the host state for the NFMC 2021Convention in Norfolk at The Waterside, a Sheraton hotel. As the host state, Virginia will receive 25% of the profits for our scholarships. Committee members are: Sandra Anderson, Wendell Anderson, Lana Bailey, Dr. Zuill Bailey, Judy Barger-Edgell, Cynthia Elmore, Kathyrn Peters, Susan Tury

2021 will be the 100th anniversary of VFMC.

The Nominating Committee for 2019-2020 VFMC officers is: District I – Jean Frazier District II – Sandra Anderson District III – Pam Kelly

In addition, Dr. Cheryl Davis and Kathryn Peters were nominated from the floor. Dr. Cheryl Davis will serve as chairman. The committee will present the slate of officers at the spring convention.

The election was held for VFMC Representative to National: Susan Tury was nominated by Linda Lind. Approved

Elections were held for VFMC nominees for National Member-at-Large. Nominees must meet certain qualifications: must be active in a senior club, at the regional, state and national levels. Nominated were: Wendell Anderson by Dr. Zuill Bailey

Dr. Zuill Bailey by Susan Tury Linda Lind by Cynthia Elmore

Dr. Cheryl Davis made a motion to close the nominations and that all three names be submitted to National. Approved

The Overall VFMC Competitions & Award Chair Nackie Steinbach explained competitions and awards available for students. More information is needed about the Hunt biennial/Mary Smart eligibility rules for vocalists and will be brought to the May meeting.

President Dr. Elaine Brady stated that there is a need for a **VFMC Editor**. A website update conference was held with Sharon Hale, Kathryn and Jeff Peters, Elaine and Paul Brady. Sharon Hale is the new website editor.

We have a new senior club – Loudoun Festival Club.

District III issued the invitation to the 2019 VFMC Convention to be held May 16-18 in South Hill. The meetings will be at the Presbyterian church and the hotel will be the Holiday Inn Express.

President Dr. Elaine Brady will attend all three District meetings in October. District I is October 6th, hosted by Tazewell Music Club. District II is October 5th and hosted by Shenandoah Valley Music Club. District III will be October 27th hosted by Rappahannock Music Study Club. Dr. Cheryl Davis, president of Rappahannock Study Club, asked that chairman send confirmation when a report is received.

Treasurer Lana Bailey thanked District I for a great convention in April in Roanoke and Dr. Elaine Brady for a productive meeting today.
